












# PLANT INFO

## SEEDS

Common name		Latin name	Germination time	Difficulty	Growing tips
Sunflower*		<i>Helianthus annuus</i>	7-14 days	Easy	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost.
Daisy		<i>Bellis perennis</i>	10-15 days	Easy	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost. Flowers bloom a year after
Carnation		<i>Dianthus barbatus</i>	10-15 days	Easy	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost. Flowers bloom a year after
Forget me not		<i>Myosotis sylvatica</i>	14-21 days	Medium	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost. Flowers bloom a year after
Basil		<i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	6-10 days	Easy	Start indoors all year round. Can be kept indoors all year round or planted in a greenhouse after the frost.
Thyme		<i>Thymus vulgaris</i>	14-25 days	Easy	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost.
Sage		<i>Salvia officinalis</i>	14-25 days	Easy	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost.
Coriander		<i>Coriandrum sativum</i>	8-12 days	Easy	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost.
Chia		<i>Salvia hispanica</i>	10-21 days	Medium	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost.
Cherry tomato*		<i>Solanum lycopersicum</i>	8-10 days	Easy	Start indoors in the spring. Plant in a greenhouse or garden after the last frost.
Spruce*, or called Norway Spruce		<i>Picea abies</i>	14- 21 days	Easy	Start indoors all year round. Plant in a garden after the last frost.
