## ■ PURPOSE

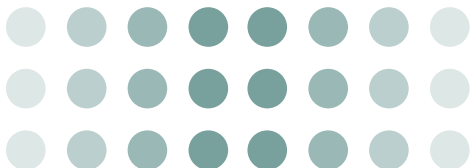
### *What is the purpose of the Glen Ellyn Library Foundation?*

The Mission of the Glen Ellyn Library Foundation is to provide an additional source of revenue to the Glen Ellyn Public Library and thereby enrich its role in the community through the establishment of an endowment fund supported by planned giving opportunities and fundraising.

## ■ NEED

### *Why does the Library need a Foundation?*

The public library is at the heart of the Village. It serves residents of all ages, races, creeds, and socioeconomic levels. The community's quality is reflected in the quality of its public library. The Glen Ellyn Public Library is primarily supported by property taxes, but there are legal and political limits to its ability to levy taxes. In order to maintain a level of taxation that is reasonable for most residents, the Library needs to supplement its tax funds from other sources. The Foundation accepts both outright and deferred gifts of all sizes from anyone who wishes to support the Library.



## ■ GOALS

### *How will the money be used?*

The costs to establish (let alone maintain) a library at the current state-of-the-industry is significant. In recent years, several libraries in our area have expanded offerings and programs aggressively. To remain at the forefront in our community we require an evergreen capital pool to:

- Keep current information technology platforms.
- Renovate and remodel facilities to promote library usage.
- Maintain current materials and incorporate new electronic formats.
- Launch new teen and outreach programs.
