

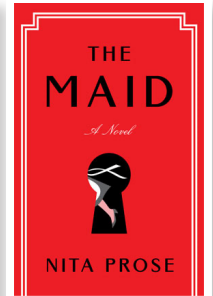
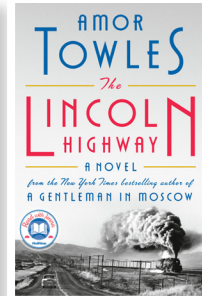
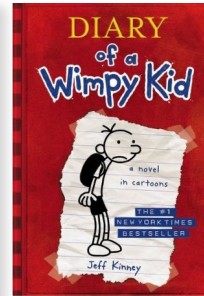

### ELEVATOR REFURBISHMENT

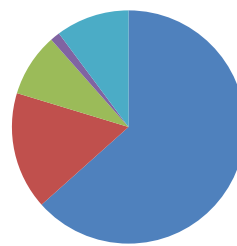
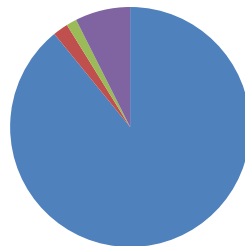
In late 2022, both library elevators were refurbished to improve reliability, safety, energy efficiency, comfort, and appearance.
